ARTISTIC DIRECTOR'S PROGRAM NOTES



Welcome to the Willamette Master Chorus Winter Concert. I am so pleased to offer this third concert of the 2020-21 season virtually. As promised, we are delighted to collaborate with the popular Severin Sisters. They are a Willamette Valley musical gem and will offer original and traditional bluegrass music individually and with the chorus.

To me, folk, bluegrass and gospel are musical styles that come from the earth and have a foundational feel. They rise from the land, reflecting and celebrating humanity's shared experiences.

The WMC will be offering the Scottish folk song *Auld Lang Syne*, newly arranged by Willamette University alum Jeff Decker. We are pleased to welcome Jeff to the WMC family of composers and arrangers.

Sing My Child is an original composition by Canadian composer Sarah Quartel.

This fresh new composition calls all of us to sing and celebrate our lives through song during a troubling pandemic. Our goal is to keep singing and bringing music into the lives of our audience even though we cannot gather in person.

Amy, Heidi, and Haley bring their unique Severin Sisters sound through an original instrumental entitled *The Gristmill*. This piece has Amy doubling on guitar and banjo, and Heidi will play mandolin and violin with Haley holding up the group on bass.

Haley is featured in a vocal/instrumental rendition of the well-known spiritual *Down to the River to Pray*. Thank you, Severin Sisters!

One of my favorite biblical texts is Micah 6:8: "He has shown you what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, to love kindness, and walk humbly with your God?" Minnesota-based composer Carol Barnett has set this text for bluegrass ensemble and vocal trio. Written in 2017, the piece calls all of us to live our lives seeking justice, kindness, and humility.

We end our concert with two old-time gospel tunes that are frequently played at bluegrass jam sessions.

I'll Fly Away and *Unclouded Day* come from rural church settings that allude to moving on to an afterlife that is free from hardship and challenges. These arrangements were put together especially for these performances this afternoon. My sincere thanks to Washington-based composer Kirk Marcy and our own David Schmidt and Chris Jones.

I hope this music touches the roots of your soul and inspires you to reflect on the short time that we have on this earth. I also hope that it creates a space to savor and cherish every day.

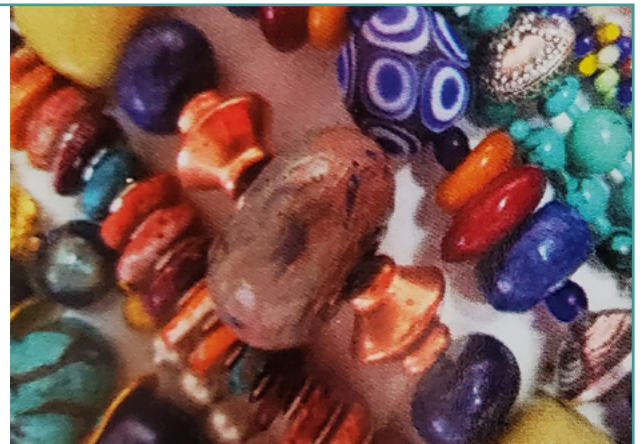

On just terrain will mercy reign.

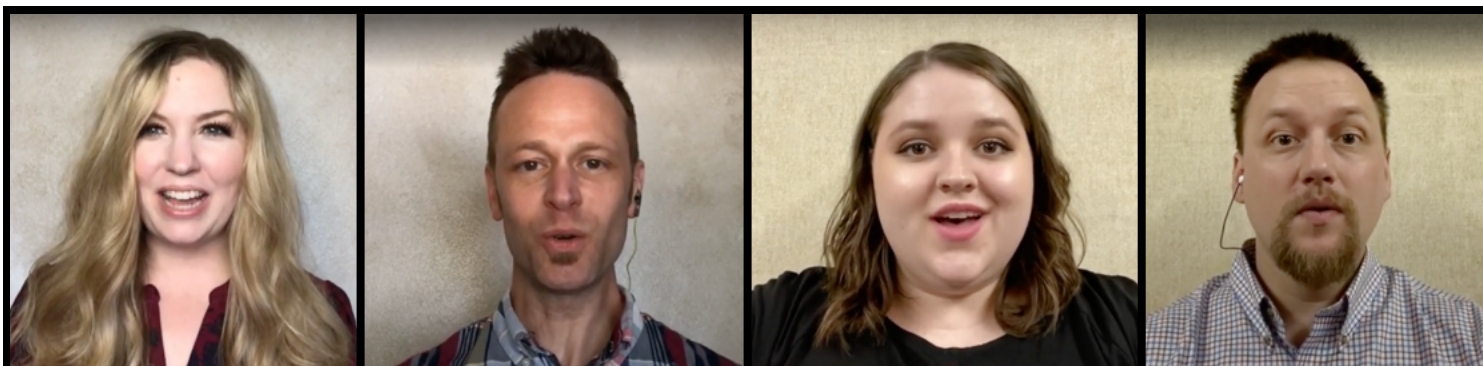
2020/2021 SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

Each year, the Willamette Master Chorus awards up-to-four \$1,000 scholarships to outstanding vocal students at Willamette University. Recipients are chosen on the basis of academic achievement, musicianship, and leadership. The scholarships are made possible by a generous bequest from the Carol Clark Tatkon Estate.

Anika Vanderwal is a Graduating Senior here at Willamette University. While she has spent the last four years in Salem working on her Bachelors in Vocal Performance, she originally is from the east coast. She moved from her hometown of Bridgeport, Connecticut to pursue her goal of becoming a professional musician. 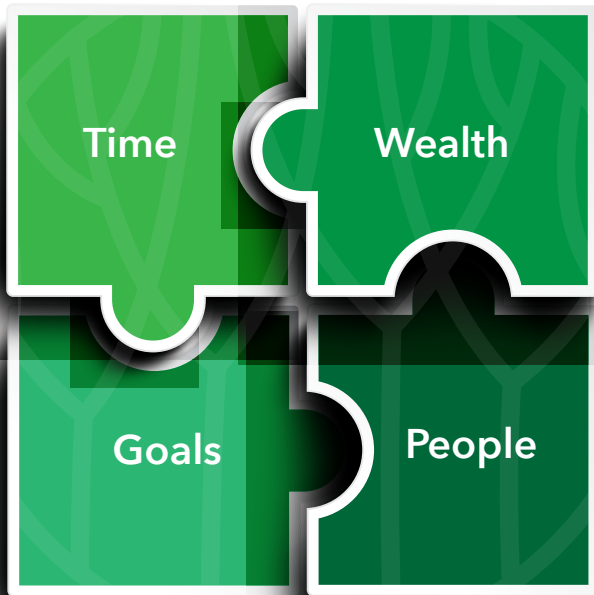
